



Figure legend: EEG findings of 28 patients who were monitored including timing of recording relatively to the onset of symptoms. EEG findings were color coded (top right corner) depending on epileptiform significance, from light blue (least correlated to seizures) to dark brown (seizure). Most seizures and epileptiform discharges were detected within 24 hours of hooking electrodes and no seizures recurred on prolonged monitoring. Abbreviations: Intermittent slow (IS), intermittent rhythmic slow (IRS), generalized (G), lateralized (Lat), continuous slow (CS), periodic pattern (PP), sharp waves (SW), LPD (lateralized periodic discharges), BIPD (bilateral independent periodic discharges).
